

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2020-10

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE FUND EXCLUSVEILY FOR THE VILLAGE OF APPLE CREEK TO RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER FUNDS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, ORC 5705.12 permits Ohio Villages to establish funds wherein money derived from specific sources other than general property tax shall be paid directly into such funds; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Apple Creek hereby desires to establish a separate CARES Act fund in order to more property administer and account for funds in the Village's possession as received via the CARES Act; and

WHEREAS, the measures taken herein are time sensitive, Village Council of Apple Creek determines these measures to be in the best interests of the village's public health and safety, and hereby declares an emergency in order for them to go into effect as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Fiscal Officer shall establish a CARES Act Fund for administration of all funds received via the CARES Act.

SECTION 2. The Fiscal Officer shall consult with the Auditor of State regarding approval of this fund.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that this Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare and that Council maintain the Village's financial records in accordance with applicable state and federal law.

SECTION 4: All prior resolutions which conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION 5: If any provision of this resolution, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions are severable.




