

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE MASTER DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH AECOM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Village of Apple Creek and AECOM Technical Services, Inc., have previously entered into a Master Design Engineering Services Agreement (“MDESA”) on June 20, 2018 whereby the Village employs AECOM for provision of engineering and technical services; and

WHEREAS, the Village is presently engaged in a large scale construction project for extension of the village’s sidewalks which requires engineering and contract bidding services; and

WHEREAS, due to expiration of certain terms in the aforementioned MDESA, an extension is required in order for AECOM to accommodate the village’s immediate needs in order to complete the pending sidewalk project and not lose potential sources of funding; and

WHEREAS, AECOM has proposed a Task Order Form (attached as Exhibit “A”) which would extend the essential terms of the prior MDESA between the parties from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Apple Creek Council has deemed it an emergency and in the Village’s best interests, and promoting of the Village residents’ general health and welfare, to approve and enter into said agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. in order to fulfill the sidewalk project.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio that:

SECTION 1.

This Council hereby approves the submitted terms as attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and agrees to enter into said Agreement with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. Said extension shall run from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021 under said terms.

SECTION 2.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign said agreement on behalf of the Village of Apple Creek.

SECTION 3.

All prior Resolutions and Ordinances and parts of Resolutions and Ordinances which conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.




