

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Monitoring requirements not met for Apple Creek Village

Apple Creek Village public water system is required to monitor your drinking water for corrosion control indicators. During the July-December 2020 monitoring period, Apple Creek Village public water system failed to collect the water quality parameter samples required and failed to report water quality parameter results on time to Ohio EPA.

### What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Apple Creek Village PWS did not monitor and/or report results for corrosion control indicators as required by Ohio EPA during the July-December 2020 monitoring period. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

### What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the required parameters. Apple Creek Village will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
