ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 2021-19, 2020-22, 2019-19, 2018-23 AND ANY AND ALL PRIOR PAYROLL ORDINANCES, AND ADJUSTING THE SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE PART-TIME ASSISTANT TO THE FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio ("Village") has passed Ordinance Nos. 2021-19, 2020-22, 2019-19 and 2018-23 in order to establish a schedule of compensation for the Part-Time Assistant to the Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined to modify the rate of compensation for said position in order to remain competitive with other similarly situated municipalities and to compensate said position based upon experience; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined this amendment to be in the best interests of the Village's residents, as it promotes the general health, welfare and safety of said citizenry, and must be passed on an emergency basis for budgetary purposes and to continue the fiscal health of the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio, that all prior payroll ordinances are heretofore amended in pertinent parts as follows, with all remaining unaltered provisions continuing in full effect:

SECTION ONE:

Part-Time Assistant to the Fiscal Officer

The rate of pay will be \$20.79 per hour.

SECTION TWO: All benefits and prior terms of employment currently in place and not addressed herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE: All prior Ordinances and parts of Ordinances which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith. If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions are severable.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency

lies in the fact that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare.
