

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-6

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A TWO-YEAR EXTENSION BID OF KIMBLE RECYCLING & DISPOSAL, INC. FOR WASTE REMOVAL SERVICES AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF APPLE CREEK TO EXECUTE SAID CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.14 and 731.141 permit the Village to extend waste refuse services contracts without competitive bidding if its annual value is less than \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, since 2013 the Village has contracted with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. for exclusive waste refuse removal services in the Village, said contract expiring on June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. has offered a two-year extension of the Village's waste refuse contract on similar terms as the prior extension, with a monthly increase in year one to \$14.29 per residence, and with the total annual contract value being less than \$50,000;

WHEREAS, immediate and ongoing provision of such waste refuse removal services is vital to the Village and its residents for its continuing health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, Apple Creek Council has deemed it in the Village's best interests, and promoting of the Village residents' general health and welfare, to approve said terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio that:

SECTION 1.

This Council hereby approves the submitted terms as attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and agrees to enter into said Contract with Kimble Recycling & Disposal, Inc. Said extension shall run from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2024 under said terms.

SECTION 2.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign said contract extension on behalf of the Village of Apple Creek.

SECTION 3.

All prior Resolutions and Ordinances and parts of Resolutions and Ordinances which conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage. The reason for the emergency lies in the fact that this Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety and welfare.

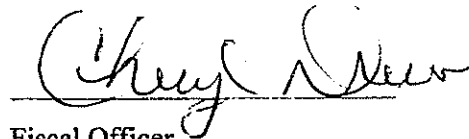

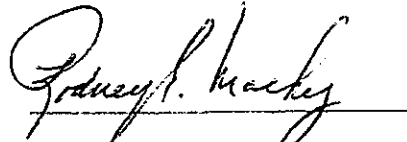
