

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PREVIOUS ORDINANCES AND ADJUSTING THE SCHEDULE OF COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS OF 4% FOR NON-ELECTED EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio (“Village”) passed Ordinance No. 2023-02 in order to establish the schedule of compensation and benefits for non-elected employees of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has decided to modify certain rates of compensation and benefits contained in said Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined this amendment is in the best interests of the Village’s residents, promotes the general welfare of said citizenry, and must be passed on an emergency basis in order to prevent hardship to non-elected employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio, that all Sections of said Ordinances shall be amended, in pertinent parts, as follows with all remaining unaltered provisions continuing in full effect:

SECTION ONE:

Police Chief Over Apple Creek Police Department

The Police Chiefs’ salary shall be set at \$57,432.96 per year with full available benefits. The Police Chief shall further be eligible for no more than one hundred fifty (150) hours of “compensatory time off” as approved by the mayor and in accordance with the terms of Ordinance 2014-7.

Sergeant

The Sergeants’ rate of pay shall be \$21.93 per hour

Full Time Police Officers

The Full-Time Police Officers’ rates of pay shall be \$20.50 per hour

Part Time Police.

The Part-Time Officers’ rates of pay shall be \$16.46 per hour

Fiscal Officer

Fiscal Officer’s rate of pay shall be \$ 25.48 per hour

Street Superintendent

The Street Superintendents’ rate of pay will be \$25.30 per hour.

Street Assistant –

Street Assistants' rate of pay shall be \$21.84 per hour.

SECTION TWO: The Employees will contribute 10% of the Hospitalization.

SECTION THREE: All prior Ordinances and parts of Ordinances which conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the first working/holiday day in 2024.
