

RESOLUTION NO: 2024-12

**A RESOLUTION PERMITTING LIMITED ALTERATION OF DRAINAGE
DITCHES ON EYMAN DRIVE PURSUANT TO PREAPPROVED PLANS
SUBMITTED TO THE VILLAGE.**

WHEREAS, property owners Daniel and Mary Lou Cross of 181 Eyman Drive and Richard and Debra of 165 Eyman Drive petitioned the Village pursuant to Section 152.002(B) of the Village of Apple Creek Codified Ordinances in order to make certain modifications to their drainage ditches on their said properties; and

WHEREAS, said property owners have submitted plans to the village for improvements in order to minimize negative impact on run-off flow rates and volumes, yet prevent wash out, which has been reviewed and approved by the Village; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has determined this resolution is in the best interests of the Village's residents, promotes the general welfare of said citizenry, and residents Edmunds and Lewis have acted in conformity with the requirements of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Apple Creek, Ohio as follows:

SECTION I:

That Village of Apple Creek hereby authorizes residents Cross and Conrad to make only those modification to their drainage ditches at 181 Eyman Drive (PP#28-00516.087 - Wayne County – Daniel and Mary Lou Cross) and 165 Eyman Drive (PP#28-00516.088 - Wayne County – Richard and Debra Conrad), Apple Creek, Ohio which have been pre-approved by the Village in writing and are in conformity with Codified Ordinance Section 152.002(B).

SECTION II:

All prior Resolutions and Ordinances and parts of Resolutions and Ordinances which conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION III:

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as soon as possible upon its passage.




